PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE: A Big Year for Corvette and the USA 1969

Neil Armstrong, Buzz Aldrin and Mike Collins were aboard Apollo 11 and en-route to man's first Moon landing on July 18, 1969 build date of this Corvette convertible.

With nearly 40,000 cars produced, this was an outstanding year for Corvette. 1969 was the first year for the 350 cubic inch displacement engine in Corvette. This Cortez Silver vehicle was equipped with the L-46 option. It got an upgraded 350 engine with 350 horsepower and 380 foot pounds of torque. This vehicle was equipped with the Muncie M-21 four-speed transmission that was often referred to as the rock crusher.

With a matching engine number, the only thing keeping this Corvette from being in factory condition appears to be the later model Corvette cassette player with amp.

The vehicle is used for pleasure cruses, car shows and has been to a driver training session or two.

Corvette Track Day at Hallett Motor Speedway Friday, May 12th

I spoke with the owner of Hallett Motor Racing Circuit. She is **probably** willing to conduct a Corvette track day on Friday, May 12th. This is the Friday before our National Council of Corvette Clubs sanctioned twoday event on Mother's Day weekend, May 13th and 14th. The determining factor is the number of participants. There must be at least 10 drivers willing to pay \$300. In addition, the drivers must hold either a high- speed-touring license from the Hallett Motor Racing Circuit or an NCCC high-speed license. If there are more participants, the price will go down. Fifteen drivers lowers the price to \$250.

In addition to the track day, she is willing to conduct a one-day driver's school for those that do not hold a high-speed license. The school will cost an additional \$50. There must be at least 3 students to conduct the school with a maximum of 5. Upon satisfactory completion of the school, the student will receive a high-speed license from the Hallett Motor Racing Circuit. This is an accepted course to obtain a high-speed license from NCCC.

The event will be conducted under the rules of the Hallett Motor Racing Circuit. Long pants, closed toe shoes and long sleeves are required attire. Run groups will consist of a maximum of 5 vehicles.

The determining factor is the number of committed drivers. If you want to attend the track day or the school with the track day, please notify Connie at <u>connie@hallettracing.net</u>.

Nationally: 2017 National Convention will be held in Bowling Green, KY. August 21-25th. Registration is currently open and you can sign up thru the NCCC website.

For clubs that want to start 1/8 mile drag events, they will have factored indexes of .64. (1/4 mile time x .64) Sea level correction will still be adjusted.

The new C7 Grand Sport will continue to compete in class N with the supercharged Z06's. Time will tell if there will be a separate class for drag events but as of right now, they're together.

News from the regional level:

The SW region has a new club: Contraband Corvette Performance Drivers with a majority of its members from the Lake Charles area.

The SW region competition calendar is on the regions website. Check the dates and make yourself available.

The first autocross of the season will be in Waco April 1-2 at the Baylor Stadium parking lot.

The 2nd is Texas Motor Speedway and the event flyer is now available on the SW region website. The event will be held April 29th and 30th. The early registration deadline and the BEST price is April 15th (Tax Day).

Hallet on May 13&14th will now have a Friday play day the 12th, hosted by the track. They must have at least 10 entries for it to be available. Must have long pants and long sleeves and closed toe shoes. The track will be providing a driving school for an additional \$50 dollars. (Must have 3 students with a maximum of 5). Completion of the school will allow you to compete that weekend. To attend the Friday play day you must contact the track- connie@hallettracing.net. If she gets 10 entries the cost will be \$300, 15 at \$250, and 20 entries at \$200 (20 is the max).

May 27th and 28th Memorial weekend will be our event, 7 Low speeds at the Edmond Fire Dept. training center and 3 Drag events at Thunder Valley. This is in our backyard so PLEASE attend and show everyone why we're #1 in the region.
